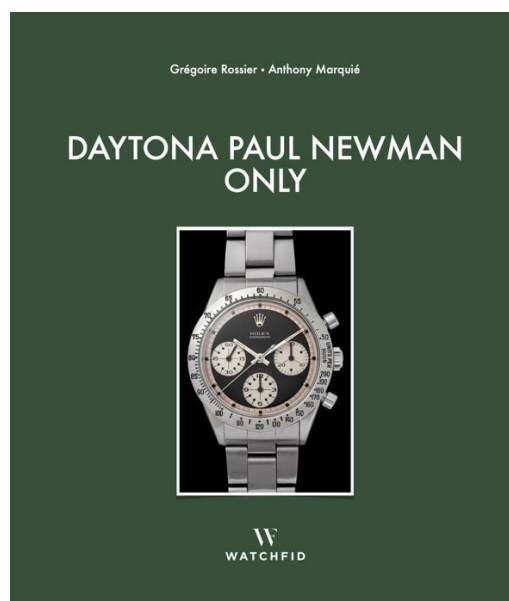
The Rolex Cosmograph Daytona 'Paul Newman' is without doubt the most emblematic watch model in the eyes of the general public, all brands included.

Produced between around 1966/67 and 1972, it is extremely difficult - if not impossible - to ascertain the precise number of Cosmograph Daytonas originally sold with this exotic dial. Firstly, there is insufficient data on the ratio of Daytona models with standard dials to those with the exotic dial. Secondly, it is well known that exotic dials were initially unpopular and often replaced by standard dials. Later, when exotic dials - renamed 'Paul Newman' - became famous and highly sought after by collectors, the trend was reversed: many standard dials were replaced by 'Paul Newman' dials.

Today, the "Paul Newman" Daytona models stand apart from the standard Daytonas, and are often considered a category of their own. These exotic dials have been fitted to almost all hand-wound Cosmograph references - with the exception of the 6269 and 6270 - with variations specific to both model and production period. Offered in numerous configurations on steel and gold models, they are the subject of the analysis presented in this new book.

This new digital book presented by WATCHFID is probably the most comprehensive guide to these models available today. No research this precise or methodical has ever been published before.

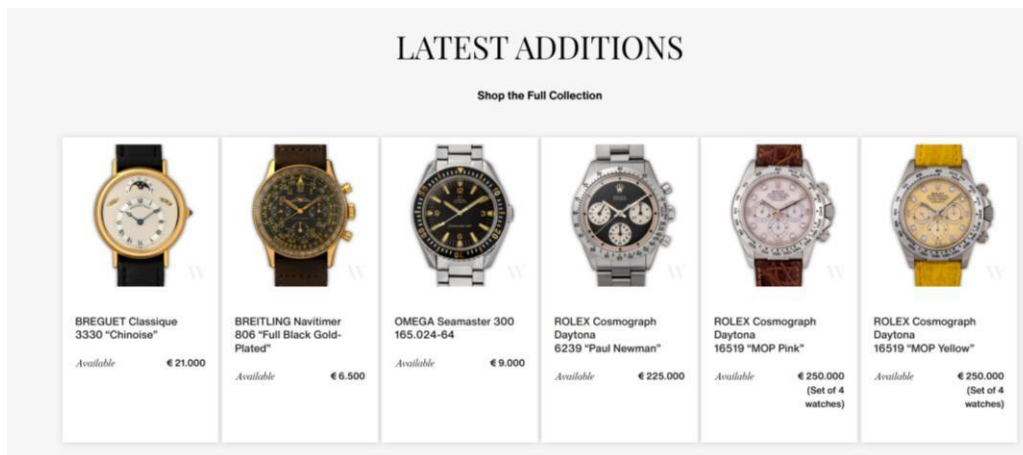

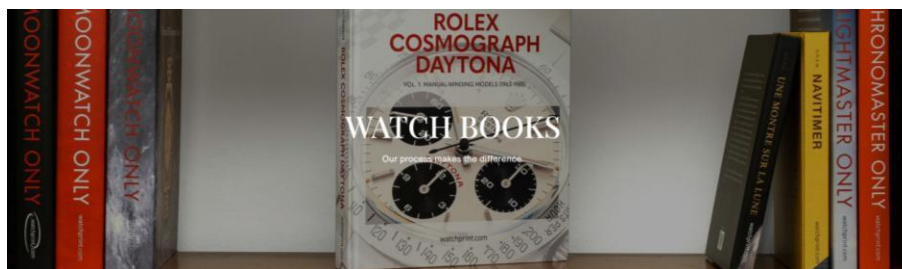
